Plastics & Metals

Place in your recycling container:

bi-metal cans

or tie in a bundle:

All cardboard and boxes must be
cut up to the size of a folded
newspaper.

Office Paper

Please put in PAPER bags.
NO PLASTIC BAGS

whole paper pages

Items Not Accepted:

NO Glass of any kind

automotive tires

construction materials

items containing Freon

hazardous waste or paint

Styrofoam

Helpful Hints:

- KEEP PAPER + CARDBOARD SEPARATE FROM PLASTICS AND METALS
- Set your recyclables out the night before Collection Day.
- Make sure your recyclable materials are secure and the lid of your recycling can is firmly attached especially in windy weather.
- Do not place your recyclables in plastic bags. Use paper bags or tie with string.
